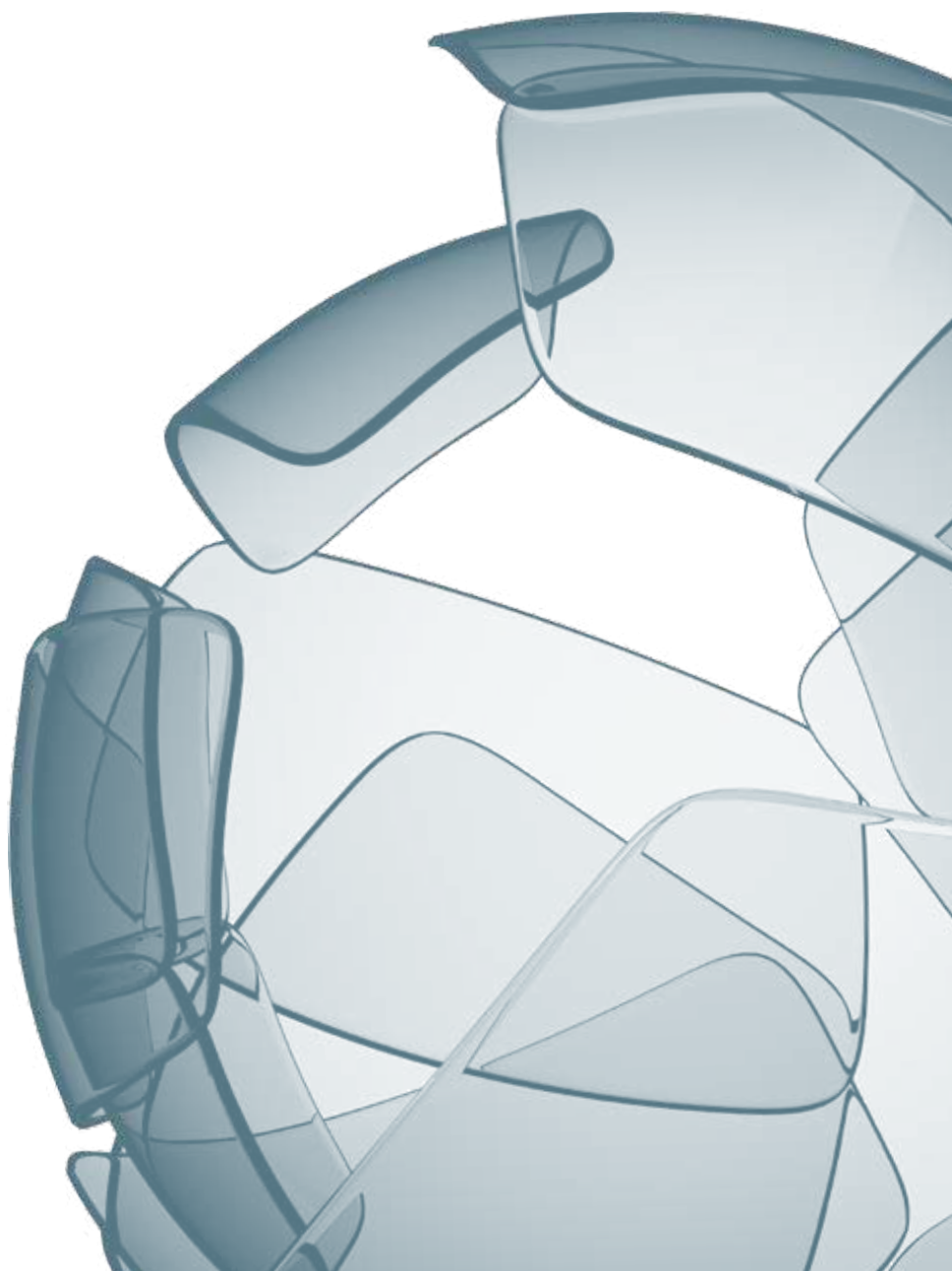

The first meeting of the International Board was held in the Football Assⁿ. Rooms London on Wed. 2nd June 1886. There were present Major Marindin (who occupied the chair) & C. W. Alcock (who acted as Secy) representing England Messrs R. Brown (President) & Asst Kennedy (Vice President) of the Scottish Assⁿ. Messrs. Asst. Hunter^(Secy) & Mills-Roberts of the Welsh Assⁿ. and Messrs J. Sinclair (Vice President) & J. McAlery (Secy) of the Irish Assⁿ.

Major Marindin having intimated the agenda the meeting proceeded with the framing of rules for the International Board the following being adopted (See card)

Major Marindin wished the conference to homologate the following resolution viz: "That no player shall wear any kind of projection on the soles or heels of his boots with the exception of flat leather bars of an approved pattern". Wales supported the proposal but Scotland & Ireland supported the previous question, & eventually the proposal was withdrawn. Votes 7 thanks to the chairman & Secretary terminated the proceedings.
