

indimeted proposed by M. Thomas RESOLUTIONS. neutral By FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION OF WALES. (1.) "That neutral Linesmen officiate in all International Matches." Fress Thomas TM have flen (2.) "That each National Association—for Trial and International Matches—have the right to the services of any player or players who may be playing for any Club or Clubs under the jurisdiction of any other National Association," IF No. 2 BE CARRIED, TO ADD-(3) "That such player and the Club to which he belongs, for refusing or neglecting to comply with the request for such player's services, be liable to be dealt with for misconduct by the Association requiring his services," or as the Board shall determine.
