Law 12 - Fouls and Misconduct - additional clarification: Restarting play after dissent/offensive language remains an indirect free-kick

The change in Law 12 of the Laws of the Game 2016/17 to a direct free kick (previously indirect free kick) for an offence against 'a team-mate, substitute, substituted player, team official or match official' is only for physical/contact offences directly against a person and not for dissent/offensive, insulting or abusive language etc.

If the referee stops play for acts of dissent, offensive, insulting or abusive language, etc. play is restarted with an indirect free kick.
